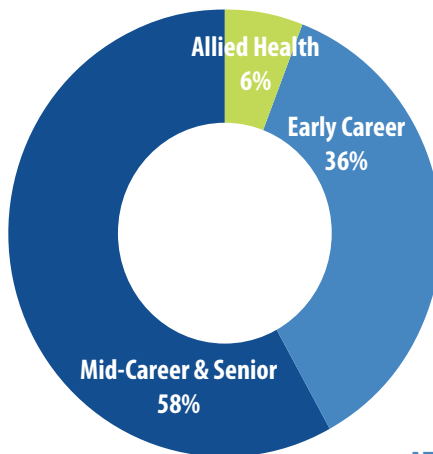

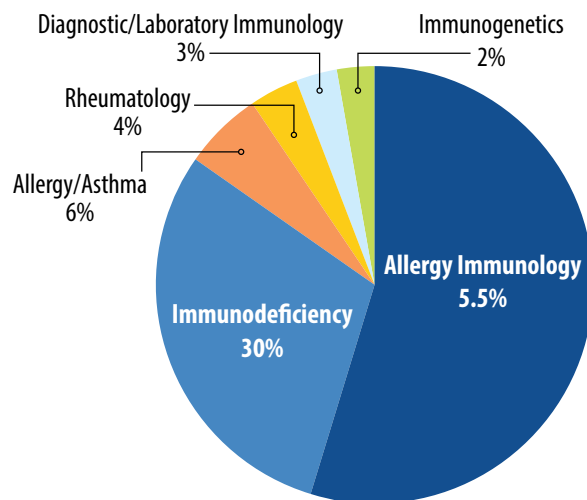

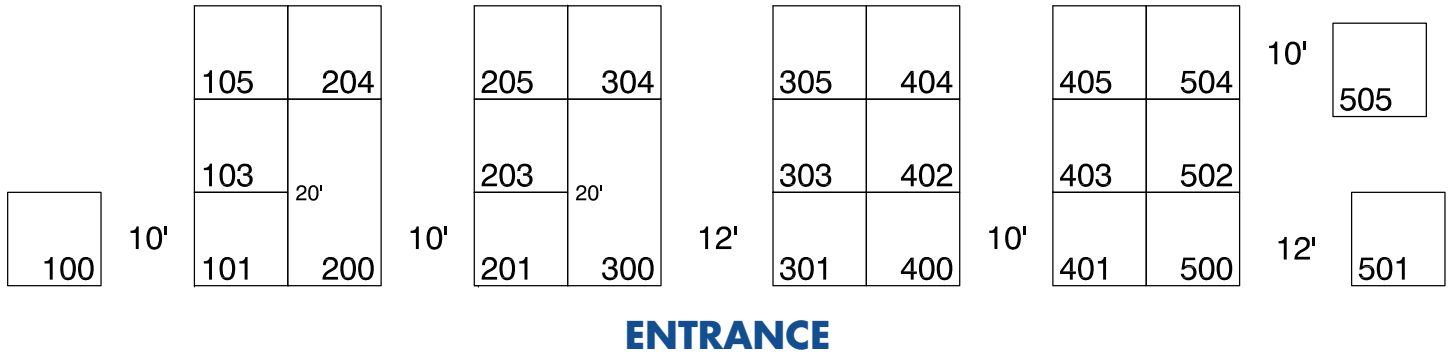

# POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

## EXHIBITOR REGISTRATION

All exhibitor personnel must be registered. Two complimentary exhibitor/delegate badges are provided to each exhibitor. Each exhibiting company is allowed additional exhibitor registrations at \$350 per exhibitor/delegate badge or \$75 per exhibitor only badge.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

Requests for cancellation of exhibit space must be made in writing. Written cancellations received before February 18, 2022, will receive a refund of 80%. Refunds will not be issued after February 18, 2022. Requests for cancellation should be sent to [info@clinimmsoc.org](mailto:info@clinimmsoc.org)

## MATERIAL HANDLING

CIS has contracted with Heritage as our exhibitor services manager. The handling of all material in and out of the exhibit hall will be performed by Heritage and will be charged according to the published handling rates.

## LABOR REGULATIONS

## INDEPENDENT SERVICE CONTRACTOR

Exhibiting companies may opt to use independent service contractors for installation and dismantle. Independent contractors are responsible for notifying CIS and Heritage of the booths they will work in and must provide a proof of insurance, including property damage, by February 18, 2022. If information is not received by this date the exhibitor must work with Heritage Exposition Services.

## INSURANCE
